Trainer/s Bio	Professor Charles Scerri specializes in the behavioural, biochemical, neuropharmacological, and social aspects of Alzheimer’s disease and associated dementia. He holds a Ph.D. from the University of Dundee, Scotland, and currently lectures neuropathology and dementia studies to various departments at the University of Malta. He is also one of the co-founders of the Malta Dementia Society and currently acts as its Chairperson. Prof Scerri is Vice-Chair of Alzheimer Europe, is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the European Joint Programme for Neurodegenerative Diseases, acts as the National Focal Point on Dementia, and chairs the National Dementia Working Group.
